#### Consortium's Membership

64% of Members are volunteer led with no paid staff

LGBT+ People, their allies, friends and families benefit from the incredible work of our Members.

33% of Members asked reported that their annual income had stayed the same this year. 18% reported a decrease in income resulting in cutbacks in services, activities and staff hours.





**44%** of Members asked reported an increase in income. This increase reflects a diverse mix of income e.g. grants, trading and donations.

73% of Members operate on less than £20,000 per year. In fact the majority of those groups operate on less than £5,000.



#### A Snap Shot of Growing Need

**85%** of groups asked reported an increase in the amount of people seeking support from their group. That figure has increased by nearly 31% since 2016.

**40%** of the groups reporting an increase 2019 saw more trans people seeking their services and support than ever before. 2018 5 million The number of people benefiting from the work of 4.8 million Consortium's 2017 **Members** 3.6 million 2015 - 2019

**57%** of Members have engaged in training, attended a conference or taken advantage of a networking opportunity offered by Consortium.






**73%** of Members who engaged in training say they have increased their knowledge and skills in topics including fundraising, governance & service design.

96% of Members would recommend joining Consortium to other LGBT+ Groups, projects organisations and networks.

**40%** of Members say they have made connections with other LGBT+ Groups through their Membership, Consortium's networking events and conferences.
